**Highway Maintenance:** New STOP sign has been put up on Stout and removed from the adjacent intersection of Geier. Will be putting up a **STOP AHEAD** sign on Stout Rd. at the Township line to warn of this "New" sign.

Continue to mow road ditches and clear branches off road way right away.

**Other:** Bank CD's for total of \$160k are up for renewal. These will be renewed plus another \$40k will be added for a total of \$200k in CD's.
