Culvert on Wafle Rd will be replaced by Township for the Randall/Potter property that was removed years ago And is now needed to access the field.

Highway Maintenance: Sink hole on Wafle Rd. was filled with patch.

Bills/Payments: Bills and Payments were reviewed. Andy Potter made a motion to approve the bills. Frank Wohlrab seconded the motion. Motion carried.
