Eligibility Code

A permit to possess or use fireworks may **only** be issued to the following:

1. A public authority;
2. A fair association;
3. An amusement park;
4. A park board;
5. A civic organization;
6. A group of resident or non-resident individuals;
7. An agricultural producer for the protection of crops from predatory birds or animals.
