Procedures for building a house

1. Driveway permit

a. Ascertain whether the driveway is on a town road, county road or state highway and then apply for a permit from the appropriate official

2. Get a perc test - put in septic (County sanitary permit)

3. Submit Building permit (include drawing of where building will be on the property with estimated footage from bordering properties and roadways) to be submitted to town board at next monthly meeting along with \$50.00 fee. (minimum of 5 acres required to build)
